This is our first year under the affiliation with the Colorado Rockies and this is the first time an Antelope Valley baseball player (Mylz Jones) has been on the JetHawks roster. Mylz Jones played for Paraclete High School and then played for Cal. State Bakersfield before being drafted in 2015, by Colorado Rockies, in 13th round (377th overall).

This year's staff has Anthony Sanders as Development Supervisor, Fred Ocasio as Manager, Brandon Emanuel as pitching Coach, Derrick May at Hitting Coach, Josh Guterman as Athletic Trainer, Rob Benjamin as Strength & Conditioning, and Joey Scott as Club House Manager.

This year's roster has 8 players from California, 6 from Dominican Republic, 1 from Venezuela, and 10 from the other states within the USA. Nine played in Modesto (High -A) last year, 13 played in Ashville (Low-A), 2 played in Grand Junction (Rookie), and 1 played in Boise (short Season) this means that over half are new to High-A baseball. It will be a little different looking out on the field at the start of the first game and not seeing any players from last year's team. We all wish the past players from the Huston Astros the very best this year and future years. Most of us will continue to follow the players we were close to, but now it is time to move on and get to know our CR players.

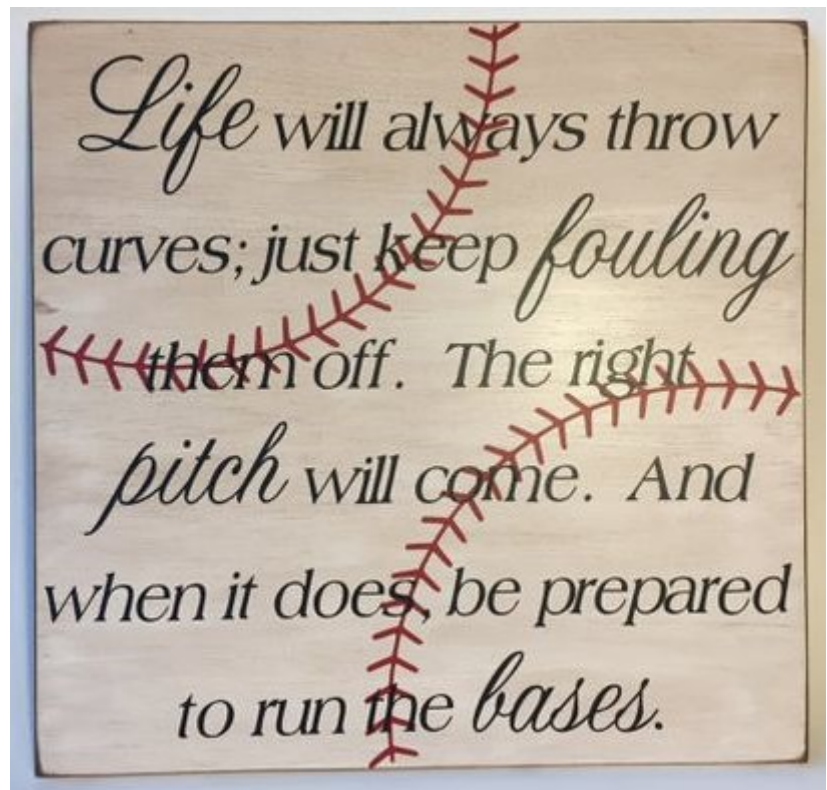

One base at a time!

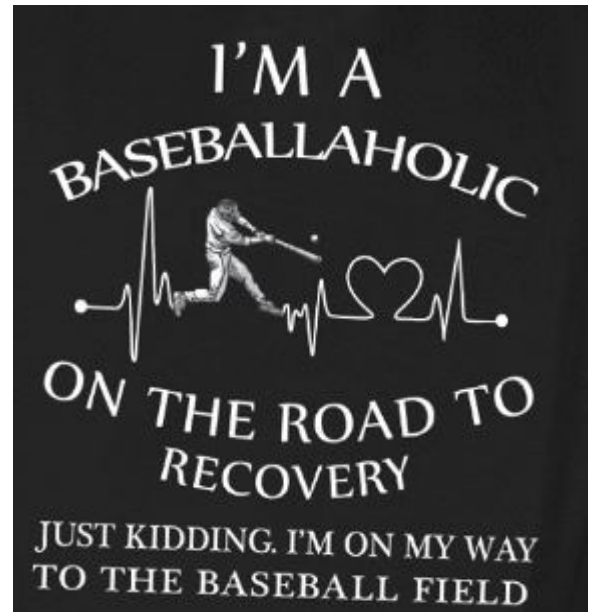
He will make a donation to the club for the players at the banquet.
